Identifying an industry leader

Peab created its enterprise architecture (EA) initiative in 2017 at a point when the construction industry was gaining digital momentum. Peab had grown to become a large organization in the Nordics, so there was significant potential to become better coordinated in business development, digital development and governance, while supporting the business in finding synergies and improving decision-making.

Amandusson and his team identified the need for effective tools to help them achieve these goals. “We definitely saw potential in being able to visualize our architecture and get visibility and insights into it, to support coordination in our business development and digital development,” he says.
