Today, MCB Group operates across **10 countries**, serving a diverse client base in **Africa, the Indian Ocean islands, and beyond**. With over 4,000 employees, the bank offers a wide range of financial solutions – from retail and corporate banking to investment services – and continues to play a pivotal role in supporting economic growth and digital transformation in the region. As of 2024, **MCB Group's total assets exceeded MUR 1 trillion**, reflecting its position as a leading financial institution in the region.

The challenge

MCB set out to transform its enterprise architecture (EA) practice but quickly encountered several roadblocks that made progress slow and fragmented.

- **Business-technology alignment was partially mapped:** It struggled to connect business capabilities with supporting technology components, making it difficult to paint a clear picture of the enterprise landscape.
- **Limited enterprise-level visibility:** Architects used different tools and approaches, which led to duplication of effort and a lack of unified direction.
- **Low EA maturity:** EA activity was largely ad hoc and closer to solution architecture.
- **Information overload:** The team was overwhelmed by conflicting information and approaches in the EA space, making it hard to define clear priorities and roadmaps.

In short, MCB needed:

- A unified platform to bring architecture artifacts, business capabilities, and technology components together.
- A collaborative environment to break down silos and enable structured contribution.
- Clear roadmaps and visualization to support decision-making and digital transformation efforts.

With these challenges in mind, MCB implemented OrbusInfinity to turn complexity into clarity and lay the groundwork for lasting enterprise-wide change.
